

## Regulations for Exchange Students

**Please read regulations for exchange students below carefully before signing. This document with a signature of an applicant must be attached with an application form.**

### 1. Class attendance

Exchange students are required to attend a class for not less than 70 percent of the total class periods throughout a semester. If the attendance is less than 70 percent, he/she may not be allowed to take the final examination of that course.

### 2. Examination

Exchange students are not allowed to take a make-up or earlier examination. Exchange students have to attend regular examinations.

### 3. Dress code

3.1 Student Uniform is mandatory for occasions as follows:

- In classrooms, assigned by the instructor.
- In examination rooms.

3.2 Polite Dress is allowed on occasions as follows:

- In classrooms, which are allowed by the instructor (only graduate courses)
- In examination rooms (only graduate courses)
- Whenever entering SIIT at both Rangsit and Bangkok campuses to contact schools or departments.

Remark: Please see the attached "Announcement of Dress Code for SIIT Students" for more details.

### 4. Dormitory

All exchange students who stay in on/off-campus dormitories, please follow the regulations of the dormitories, especially the following regulations:

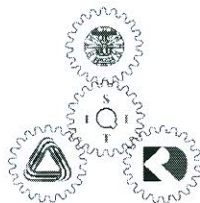
- Do not have a party in a dormitory room.
- Do not make loud noises in a room or in public area. If you invite friends to your room, please tell them to keep their voice down.
- Do not drink alcoholic beverages in public area, such as, in front of the dormitory, on walking ways, stairs, terraces, or in the lobby.

All exchange students must strictly follow the regulations. Misbehavior of exchange students will be reported to SIIT. SIIT will then report them to their home universities for further disciplinary actions.

**Announcement of Dress Code for SIIT Students**

In accordance with the announcement about dress code for Graduate and Undergraduate Students issued by Thammasat University on May 14, B.E.2551, the 34<sup>th</sup> /2014 Joint Academic and Executive Committee Meeting on September 8, 2014, has approved to issue an announcement regarding dress code for Sirindhorn International Institute of Technology (SIIT) Graduate and Undergraduate students when attending classroom/laboratory/research room or contacting faculty members or staff of SIIT and Thammasat University. Herewith, the following clothes will be considered inappropriate:

**1. For Female Students:**

- (1) Tube top, spaghetti strap, tank top, t-shirt, crop top, see-through clothes, or skintight shirt  
(เสื้อเกาะอก เสื้อสายเดี่ยว เสื้อแขนงูด เสื้อยัดคอกกลม เสื้อเอวลอยเห็นสะดือ เสื้อเนื้อผ้าโปร่งตา เสื้อรัดรูป)
- (2) Mid-thigh skirt, (inappropriate) split skirt  
(กระโปรงที่สั้นจนถึงครึ่งหนึ่งของต้นขา หรือสั้นกว่า กระโปรงผ่าลึกเกินสมควร)
- (3) Shorts, pedal pushers (three-quarter length slacks), fisherman trousers, ripped jeans, low hip trousers, skintight trousers  
(กางเกงขาสั้น กางเกงขาสามส่วน กางเกงเล กางเกงขาดไว้แหงน กางเกงที่เอวต่ำกว่าสะโพก กางเกงรัดรูป)
- (4) Pajamas (ชุดนอน)
- (5) Sandals (รองเท้าแตะ)
- (6) Any clothes that are too revealing  
(แต่งกายลักษณะใดที่เห็นได้ชัดแจ้งว่าเป็นการแต่งกายล่อแหลมจนเกินควร)

**2. For Male Students:**

- (1) Vest top, tank top, t-shirt  
(เสื้อกล้าม เสื้อแขนงูด เสื้อยัดคอกกลม)
- (2) Shorts, sport shorts, three-quarter length slacks, fisherman trousers, ripped jeans  
(กางเกงขาสั้น กางเกงกีฬาขาสั้น กางเกงขาสามส่วน กางเกงเล กางเกงขาดไว้แหงน)
- (3) Pajamas (ชุดนอน)
- (4) Sandals (รองเท้าแตะ)
- (5) Any clothes that are too revealing  
(แต่งกายลักษณะใดที่เห็นได้ชัดแจ้งว่าเป็นการแต่งกายล่อแหลมจนเกินควร)

Student who wears any cloth mentioned above will be warned and faced with the possibility of conduct scores deduction as subject to the Institute's policy. In this regards, the faculty and staff are strictly prohibited from providing any service to students wearing clothes inappropriately, as mentioned above.
